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OUR EXPERIENCE

Integrated Mine Services, Argyle Diamond Mine (2015 - 2021)

GJC commenced its operations through an initial major contract with Rio Tinto to manage general maintenance services across the Argyle Diamond Mine site.

This included roads, grounds, waste management, and bio-remediation management at the mine.

Since this time the business has consolidated its operations and performed contracts for a series of other clients and projects that demonstrate the confidence our clients have in our capacity and capability to meet contract deliverables.



Rydgies Iron Ore Mine (2019 - 2021)

Production based mining operations, including haul road maintenance, load and haul operations, dust suppression, refueling and servicing of plant and machinery, rom operations including stockpile management.

Savannah Nickle Mine (2020 - 2020)

This project involved a camp relocation at Savannah Nickel Mine. Ground preparation was undertaken, and foundations installed for placement of the camp. GJC installed all essential services such as power, water, sewerage, and construction of camp facilities.

General Site Services Contract, Argyle Diamond Mine (2021 - current)

The General Site Services is a multi-million-dollar contract as part of the Argyle Diamond Mine Closure project.

The contract includes maintenance of the accommodation village; all site facilities; airport maintenance and refueling of aircraft; grounds maintenance; plumbing and electrical maintenance (including the power station); waste management; Reverse Osmosis Plant, and mechanical servicing.

GJC continues to successfully manage the complexities of coordinating services across the mine and troubleshooting issues as they arise, resulting in a high level of client satisfaction.

Bulk Earthworks Contract, Argyle Diamond Mine (2021 - current)

Bulk Earthworks is a multi-million-dollar contract as part of the rehabilitation of the Argyle Diamond Mine. The contract includes load and haul; cut to fill to design levels; repurfing to ensure drainage and water flow; rock armour manufacturing; spillway construction; scour protection; final trim work; removal of existing roads, culverts, and infrastructure; maintenance of existing roads and drainage systems; verge clearing; and fencing.

GJC continues to draw on its highly functional operating capacity and industry knowledge to work collaboratively with contractors appointed to other work packages to meet the projects outcomes for the client.
